Safety First

Stay Out / Stay Alive

For the 11th consecutive year, the U.S. Department of Labor's Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) launched its annual "Stay Out-Stay Alive" public safety campaign to warn outdoor enthusiasts - especially children - about the dangers of playing on mine property. Since 1999, nearly 300 people have lost their lives in recreational accidents at mine properties. Almost half of all victims are 15 to 25 years of age, and the most common cause of death is drowning in a quarry. "No matter how attractive they may appear, active and abandoned mines are not playgrounds. If you're not trained or authorized to enter the property, stay away," said Michael A. Davis, MSHA's deputy assistant secretary of labor for operations. "As we near the end of another school year and prepare for lots of outdoor activities, children and young adults must be aware of the potential dangers that exist." Stoneco is taking part in the program by educating local youth in our school tour program that runs every spring. For further information about the national campaign, visit www.msha.gov.
